



# Mapping active ingredients of a parent-implemented intervention

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## What is it?

Parent involvement in intervention important for improving outcomes for children with ASD.

This project is designed to better understand how Project ImPACT, a parent-implemented intervention program, works.

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## What will you do?

Participants will complete a phone interview which will take about 45 minutes to 1 hour.

- The questions will focus on **your experience** of Project ImPACT and how it works.
  - It will include questions about coaching practices, how children respond to Project ImPACT strategies, and how Project ImPACT fits into family life and clinical practice.
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## To participate, you must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Have used Project ImPACT within the last year as a certified provider

## You will:

- Receive a \$30 gift card for completing the study interview
